It seems that it attracts people with an interest in beauty because the demand for beauty services is on the rise.

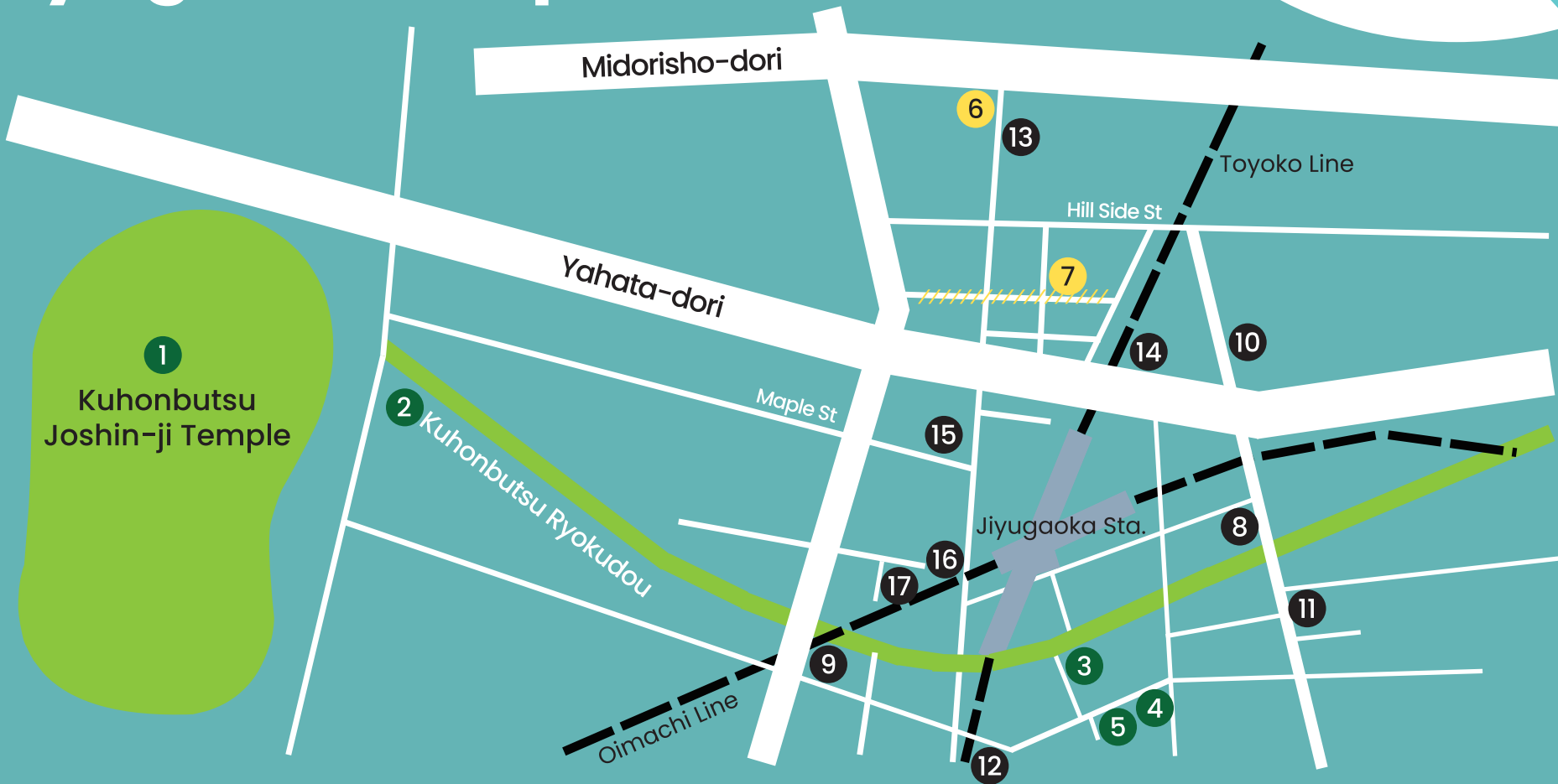
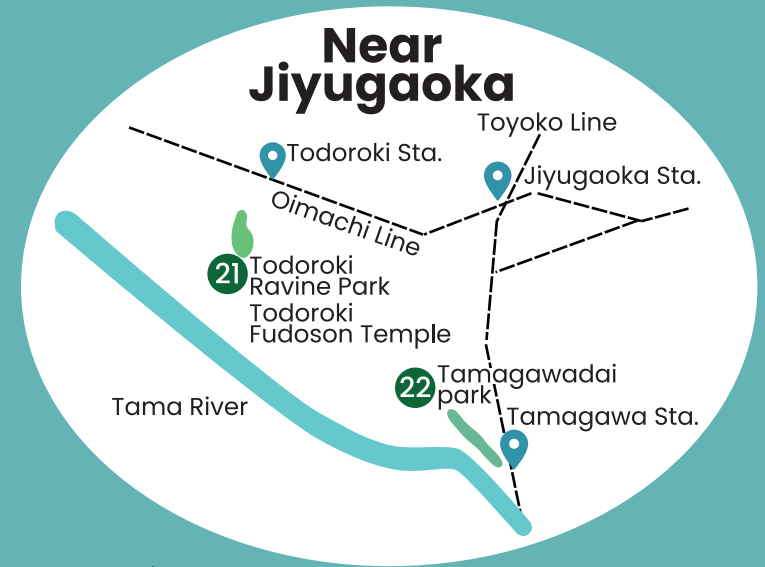
Although it is a small area, it is packed with many salons such as hair, aesthetic, and nail salons.

★How to get there

Take local Oimachi line from Jiyugaoka station on track number 1. Get off at the third station “Todoroki”. After exiting the ticket gate, go straight to the left for about 5 minutes. Pass through an intersection with a traffic light with a sign of Todoroki Fudo-mae, and a few more minutes’ walk will bring you to the gate on the right. You can also get there along the walkway in Todoroki Keikoku.
